Dear OM:

Replying to yours of June 22nd, John Reinartz has gone with the MacMillan Arctic Expedition several weeks ago and will not be back for about four months so that it will be impossible for him to give you any dope on the short waves. I think the best thing for me to do would be to pass your letter to Mr. Hatry, who conducts our Information Department at Headquarters and who has a large store of information from which he can draw to help you with your problem.

You will find in past issues of QST that the subject of short wave development has been pretty thoroughly covered in all its phases, both practical and theoretical, so that if you want to get started in advance of a reply from Mr. Hatry, I would suggest your going through past QST's for about a year and a half or two years.

I would willingly help you with this myself but Mr. Hatry is much better qualified technically to give you the complete dope.
